EMBARK ON AN UNFORGETTABLE SELF-DRIVE JOURNEY ALONG THE LEGENDARY **ROUTE 66**, STRETCHING FROM CHICAGO'S BUSTLING CITY STREETS TO THE SUNNY SHORES OF LOS ANGELES. THIS ROAD TRIP COVERS OVER **2,400 MILES** ACROSS 8 U.S. STATES, COMBINING ICONIC LANDMARKS, HISTORIC TOWNS, AND BREATHTAKING NATURAL WONDERS.

### **Day 1: Arrival in Chicago – Gateway to Route 66**

- Arrive in Chicago, the starting point of the historic Route 66. After checking into your hotel, explore the vibrant city – visit Millennium Park, Navy Pier, and the Magnificent Mile. In the evening, stand by the famous “Route 66 Begin” sign in downtown Chicago to mark the start of your adventure. Overnight stay in Chicago.

### **Day 2: Chicago to St. Louis (Approx. 480 km / 5 hrs)**

- Drive through Illinois farmland, stopping at Joliet (Route 66 Museum) and Springfield, the hometown of Abraham Lincoln. Continue south towards St. Louis. In the evening, admire the iconic **Gateway Arch** and enjoy dinner on the Mississippi Riverfront. Overnight in St. Louis.

### **Day 3: St. Louis to Tulsa (Approx. 640 km / 6 hrs)**

- Depart St. Louis and travel across Missouri. En route, stop at the quirky town of Cuba (famous for Route 66 murals) and Meramec Caverns. Visit Lebanon's Munger Moss Motel, a nostalgic Route 66 landmark. Arrive in Tulsa, Oklahoma by evening and explore the lively Blue Dome District. Overnight stay in Tulsa.

### **Day 4: Tulsa to Amarillo (Approx. 595 km / 6 hrs)**

- Today you'll drive through Oklahoma's best Route 66 attractions – the giant Blue Whale in Catoosa and the Round Barn in Arcadia. Cross into Texas and reach **Amarillo**, home to Cadillac Ranch, where you can spray-paint cars buried in the desert sand. Overnight in Amarillo.

### **Day 5: Amarillo to Albuquerque (Approx. 465 km / 4.5 hrs)**

- On your way west, stop at Adrian, TX – the official halfway point of Route 66. Visit Santa Rosa's **Blue Hole**, a natural spring-fed pool. By afternoon, reach Albuquerque and stroll through Old Town with its adobe houses, shops, and restaurants. Overnight in Albuquerque.

### **Day 6: Albuquerque to Flagstaff via Petrified Forest (Approx. 515 km / 5 hrs)**

- Drive into Arizona and explore **Petrified Forest National Park** and the Painted Desert with its colorful landscapes. Continue to Holbrook to see the Wigwam Motel, then head to Flagstaff, a charming mountain town and gateway to the Grand Canyon. Overnight in Flagstaff.

### **Day 7: Grand Canyon Excursion (Approx. 130 km one way)**

- Spend the day visiting **Grand Canyon National Park**. Marvel at the South Rim viewpoints such as Mather Point and Desert View. Enjoy short hikes, photography, or even a helicopter ride (optional). Return to Flagstaff for the night.

## **Day 8: Flagstaff to Las Vegas (Optional) OR Kingman (Approx. 400 km / 5–6 hrs)**

Choose between two routes:

- **Route 66 Path:** Head west through Seligman and Kingman, stopping at the historic Oatman town with its wild burros.
- **Las Vegas Detour:** Drive via Hoover Dam to Las Vegas and enjoy the neon lights and entertainment.

Overnight in Kingman or Las Vegas depending on your choice.

## **Day 9: Kingman/Las Vegas to Los Angeles (Approx. 560 km / 6 hrs)**

- Today marks the final stretch of your adventure. Cross the Mojave Desert and head into California. Arrive in Los Angeles, where your journey officially ends at the **Santa Monica Pier**, the western terminus of Route 66. Overnight in Los Angeles.
